 deliver them to the students during the 2020-2021 school year.
- PTO has purchased 1 of many of the items in the new catalog so people can see the items in person and we can put them on display. Total Cost of these items is \$200.

- 4. 11 School Ornaments (\$46.75 upfront cost paid by PTO) -- WE HAVE 4 LEFT
- 5. 21 School Ornaments (\$89.25 upfront cost paid by PTO) -- WE HAVE 8 LEFT
- Cash and Carry Sales: We have been selling the 5 items above in Cash and Carry Sales this week (after 4pm Mass on 12/5, after 10am Mass on 12/6, Car Pool Pickup Lines on 12/7 and 12/8). So far, we have sold \$346 worth of merchandise from the Cash and Carry Sales and we will be at both Masses this weekend.
