- We have had 28 online orders since the new St. Al's Gator Gear (spiritwear) website launched on November 16th.
- All spiritwear orders must be done via the website. Amanda owns working with Writely Sew to reconcile orders/payments and deliver them to the students during the 2020-2021 school year.
- There are 5 items that have a minimum order amount that PTO is purchasing in hopes we can sell them all.

 - 25 Adult Masks + 5 Free Bonus Masks (\$141.5 upfront cost paid by PTO). -- WE

 - 6" Allie Gator with Navy St. Al's Shirt 50 of them (\$543.5 upfront cost paid by PTO) ---- WE HAVE 32 LEFT
 - o 11 School Ornaments (\$46.75 upfront cost paid by PTO) -- WE HAVE 2 LEFT
 - o 21 Church Ornaments (\$89.25 upfront cost paid by PTO) -- WE HAVE 3 LEFT
- December Cash and Carry Sales: We made \$549 for all our December Cash and Carry Sales!
