Dear Parents,

Routines, Process and Policies.....oh my!!

Congratulations to ALL students, staff, ad faculty! K-8 has made it through the first 4 full weeks of school, and preschool has made it through 2 full weeks!!

Thank you,, families, for patience and understanding with drop off and pick up! I think we finally have a good process, that seems to be working well!

There is one big concern.....EARLY arrival of cars for dismissal. I have been asked to convey that the blocking of the alley from 1:30 (when some cars arrive!) to 2:15 is a serious SAFETY concern. That is a full 45 minutes of instruction time (full school of students) and should we have an emergency, access would be denied to the responders. I do not want to have to block entry, please show up no earlier than 15 minutes prior to dismissal. This would also apply to half day preschool, so arrive o earlier than 10:45.

K-8 had I-Ready assessments this week. The staff will be getting trained on the results and how to use the data from the test to best serve our students. This is a BEGINNING of the year assessment, scores will and should be on the lower side. Makes sense, right? The students have just gotten back and most still have their "summer" brain.

The middle of the trimester is fast approaching. This year, things will be a bit different for the interim of the trimester. Every student will NOT be receiving a "report". No new is good news! This will be the time that teachers and staff will reach out to those families that may need a conference of check-in.

I love fall! School starts, routines and pace falls into place. The air turns light and crisp. The gorgeous colors begin to emerge and students GROW!! Happy Autumn!

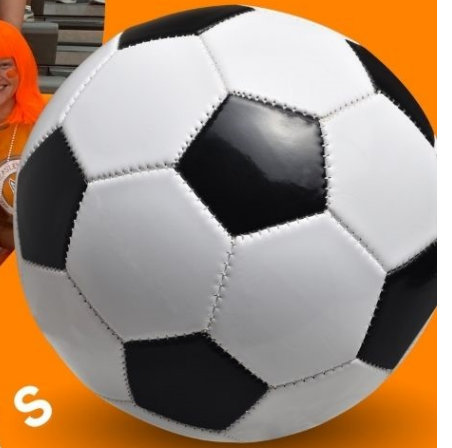
