- -Saint Aloysius students and staff will participate in a lockdown/safety drill on October 26th. This drill is designed to help prepare the school on how to respond in the event of an emergency, intruder, or active shooter situation. All schools are required to provide these drills and training sessions. This is part of our overall safety education program. Just as we conduct regular fire and tornado drills to ensure we are prepared for such emergencies; it is important that we are also prepared for an emergency that could involve a violent situation. Rest assured we will not be using the term "active shooter" during our drills, but will discuss that there is a dangerous individual in the building and to please follow the directions of their teachers. Your student's teachers will be providing training to your students. Please talk to your student about the reasons we conduct these drills and the importance of knowing how to respond and LISTEN in various emergency situations. Thank you for your cooperation.
- -Preschool will trick-or-treat in the elementary building on Tuesday, October 31st. If your child attends school on Tuesdays, please remember to send in a bag of candy! Students will wear their costumes to school with clothes underneath. They will take costumes off after they trick-or-treat. No accessories or candy buckets/bags, please!
